At the same time, we attach great importance to your verbal communication skills, so that you will soon be able to talk with the warm-hearted people of Saxony.

Intensive Course

You can book the Standard Intensive German Course at all levels throughout the year. The minimum age is 16 years and upwards there is no limit.

Basic levels A1 – B1

In the three basic levels, you will learn all skills such as listening and reading comprehension, pronunciation, grammar, writing and basic vocabulary. The focus is on speaking. You should be able to communicate quickly in your daily life and have the courage to speak German even “outside” and swiftly drop your language barriers.

Advanced levels B2 – C1

Basic vocabulary and grammar as well as your communicative skills are systematically expanded in the advanced levels. The focus is on the free use of language and coping with specific language situations such as your studies, job or exam.

Start every month

We offer a fixed start date every year throughout the year at every level.

In addition, depending on the available places, you can join the course on any Monday of the year and end on any Friday.

The *Standard Intensive German Course 25* is held Monday to Friday from 09:30 to 14:00.

1 Level in 8 weeks

With our small mixed learning groups, our professional teachers and modern communicative methods, you need a module, e.g. A1.1, only 4 weeks – and for a complete language level, e.g. A1, **only 8 weeks**.

There are two **breaks** between classes, where you can relax in Alaunpark next to the school, have a drink or snack in our cafeteria, check e-mails or chat with friends.

Summer Intensive Course

Our summer courses: *Summer Intensive Course and Summer Intensive Course 30 (with additional conversational classes)* are the right choice if you are coming to Germany/Dresden in July and August and would like to learn German in a summer school – a great combination of German language course in Germany and lots of fun & culture. With our cool daily recreational activities you can learn German and apply it immediately by meeting friends from all over the world.

You can attend our *Summer Intensive Courses* at all A1 – C1 levels.

Note: You can book the *Summer Intensive Course 30* from level A2.2.

If you are a beginner with no previous knowledge or if you want to start with a regular module (for example, B1.2) we have fixed start dates.

The Summer Course 25 starts daily at 9:30 am and ends at 02:00 pm. , and the Summer Course 30 ends 03:45 pm. from Tuesday to Thursday.

Especially in the summer course you will experience unforgettable moments, because we have even more fun and games. In the accompanying leisure and excursion program, you can use your German and get to know Germany and its people first-hand. At our regulars' table (Stammtisch), BBQs, museum visits, concerts, street parties or on excursions to Berlin Prague or Leipzig, you quickly break down language barriers and get to know the country with its friendly and open people.

Preparation Course

With our *TestDaF preparation course* we prepare you optimally for the TestDaF exam. Your TestDaF exam place is automatically reserved for you as one of our TestDaF prep course students. The prerequisite for participation in our TestDaF preparatory course is proof of the C1 level or participation in our C1 course.

Our *TestDaF Preparation* course focuses precisely on the **specific types of tasks** and skills of the TestDaF. We work on the strategies for selective reading comprehension, writing descriptions of charts and graphs, reasoning or discussing essays. In addition, we discuss typical topics in natural sciences or humanities and simulate the oral exam.

Strategy Training

Halfway through the course, you will take a **practice exam**, acquainting yourself with the real exam requirements. This "TestDaF stress test" gives you a feeling for the language level of the typical tasks and for the available time given for the TestDaF.

Based on your test result, the instructor can provide you with valuable tips and additional tasks.

TestDaF- Exam Center

We have a preparation course for all 6 worldwide TestDaF exams in 2020. All exams take place at Kästner Kolleg and by participating in our course you have a **guaranteed place**.

Evening Course

If you want to learn German in evening classes alongside your studies, job or research, then our part time courses: "After Work" are the best choice. You can study German at all levels of A1 – C1 in our German Night School year-round for two evenings a week. You can join a course at any time. Above all, in our German evening classes we train you to speak fluently and correctly. Just come by for a free trial lesson.

2 evenings per week

You can attend this part-time German course two evenings each week. Classes usually run from 6 to 8:30pm (3x45 minutes). For beginners without prior knowledge ("A0.0") there are fixed start dates. If you already have previous knowledge, take our placement test and/or come to a free trial lesson. We can always integrate you into an ongoing course.

For a module, A2.2, you need 12 weeks, for a language level, e.g. A2, a total of 24 weeks.

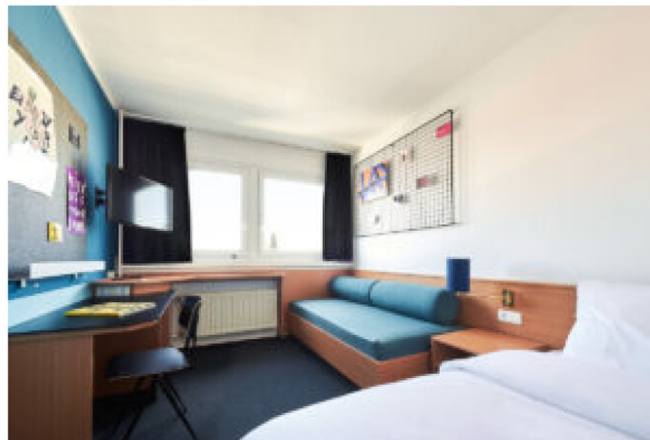
